

Contribution to Sport Award

1. To assist the sport and sports law industry, in 2004 ANZSLA introduced an award to recognise members who have made a *substantial lifetime achievement to the development, integrity and professionalism of sport and the sports law industry*. The inaugural recipient of the award was the Honourable Robert Ellicott QC. In 2006 it was awarded to David Howman, Director General of WADA; in 2008 it was awarded to Malcolm Speed, in 2009 to Hayden Opie, in 2010 to the Hon Barry Paterson CNZM, OBE, QC and in 2011 to Margot Foster.
2. Members are encouraged to nominate themselves, or fellow members, who they believe have substantially contributed to the industry. Nominees must be current ANZSLA members.
3. The deadline for submissions is the first Friday in September.
4. The ANZSLA Board will consider the nominations received and appoint the recipient of the award, to be announced at the ANZSLA conference dinner and/or on the ANZSLA website.
5. The decision of the ANZSLA Board is final. The ANZSLA Board reserves the right to withhold the Award if it believes that no such person worthy is nominated
